REFERENCE IS MADE TO OUR DISCUSSION IN LONDON ON THE 24TH OF NOVEMBER 1990 CONCERNING THE POSSIBILITIES OF LINKING ERITREA WITH THE OUTSIDE WORLD THROUGH TELETRANSMISSION. IN ORDER TO LINK TWO OR MORE COMPUTERS IN DIFFERENT LOCATIONS A RELIABLE TELECOMMUNICATION LINE BETWEEN THEM IS ESSENTIAL. DIRECT CONNECTION TO THE INTERNATIONAL TELEPHONE AND TELEX NETWORKS CAN BE ACHIEVED BY PROCURRING AND INSTALLING SATELLITE COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT IN ERITREA. THE EQUIPMENT IS PORTABLE, EASY TO OPERATE AND PROVIDES A HIGHLY RELIABLE LINE.
