Hei Eric-Anders

I tried to reach you by phone the last days without success. I am interested to know the schedule of your next trip to Eritrea.

I don't have anything to send with you but I would very much need your help on the return trip to Norway. It all concerns the replaced parts of the terminal in Eritrea, whose return to Norway, is long overdue.

Another help I need is relatd to the container we have sent from Stavanger in mid-july. The destinators inside Eritrea are aware of the shipment and are awaiting its arrival. But ERA office in Port Sudan, to whom the container is addressed, do not have the information about the shipment or its destination. So if you are leaving shortly your arrival may coincide with the arrival of the container in Port Sudan. In that case I would fax you copies of the container manifest and bill of lading for delivery to ERA port Sudan.

By the same token, are you familiar with the functions of DATA POINT 1100 computers? They belong to the generation of the early 80's and were widely used in Norway. We have sent with the container 2 computers of this type and a printer. But we didn't manage to find operating manuals. I am therefore thinking that you may be able to demonstrate the functional operations while you are there.
